CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background

Romance fiction still has a special place for society to enjoy. A lot of people enjoy romance because romance is one of the popular genres and people choose this genre to entertain themselves. At Ma Chung University, Lilis Lestari Wilujeng, Dono Sunardi, and Wawan Eko Yulianto, as a lecturer, teaching how romance has been growing from Greek romance to the modern era of romance. For example; in the middle ages, the popularity of chivalric romance was accompanied by associations of frivolousness. In this modern era, romance has been given a lesser place than the realist novel (McCracken, 1998, p. 76).

Society can enjoy romance fiction by watching or reading it. An example of romance fiction that you can watch is movies or dramas. South Korean dramas are known for their excellence in story development, intelligibility, straightforward and extreme expressions of emotions, and tears (Takeda, 2004, p. 147). For example, *The World of Married* was released on March 27, 2020. According to Nielsen Korea, "The

last episode of *The World of Married* has scored a national average rating of 28.37%, beating its record 24.44% from the previous night's episode." It shows how popular Korean Drama in society is". Another option is to enjoy romance fiction by reading it, such as a novel or short story. In the world of novels, *The Twilight Saga* by Stephenie Meyer is one of the famous romance fiction. For a short story, one of the famous writers comes from Russia, Anton Pavlovich Checkov. Some of his works are famous; such as *The Lady with the Dog* (1899), *A Living Chattel* (1882), *About Love* (1898), and *The Grasshopper* (1892).
